Best Friend Park

Best Friend Park is one of the oldest parks in the county system that is being improved through sales tax dollars. Refurbishments already completed include the renovated Hudlow Tennis Center and 16 lighted tennis courts. The Gunnin Activity Building, which houses the gymnasium, was improved with the addition of air conditioning and a classroom. Additional improvements completed include a new park entry, additional parking, improvements to the outdoor leisure pool, and two renovated adult sport fields. One of the fields is home to senior softball games, and the other adult field will have a football overlay for adult flag football leagues. Construction is being completed on an improved picnic pavilion, a new paved, multi-purpose trail, open-play areas, and relocation of the outdoor basketball courts within the park.

Holcomb Bridge Park

Holcomb Bridge Park offers great scenic views of the Chattahoochee River. Amenities include two river overlooks, a picnic pavilion, playground, a wooden amphitheatre, a mulch trail, an open-space play area, and restrooms. The picnic pavilion is available to rent for birthday parties, family reunions, and other gatherings.

Jones Bridge Park

The park features a large open field, two picnic pavilions, a playground, the Good Age Community Building, a sand volleyball court, three youth soccer fields and a concession/restroom facility. Recent renovations include the restoration of approximately 700 feet of the shoreline along the Chattahoochee River. In addition, two pedestrian bridges were replaced, providing improved access to the river. New asphalt, concrete and soft surface walkways and fencing were constructed to protect the river's vegetation, and improved handicap access to the river was made possible through a new wooden boardwalk/ramp.

Pinckneyville Park

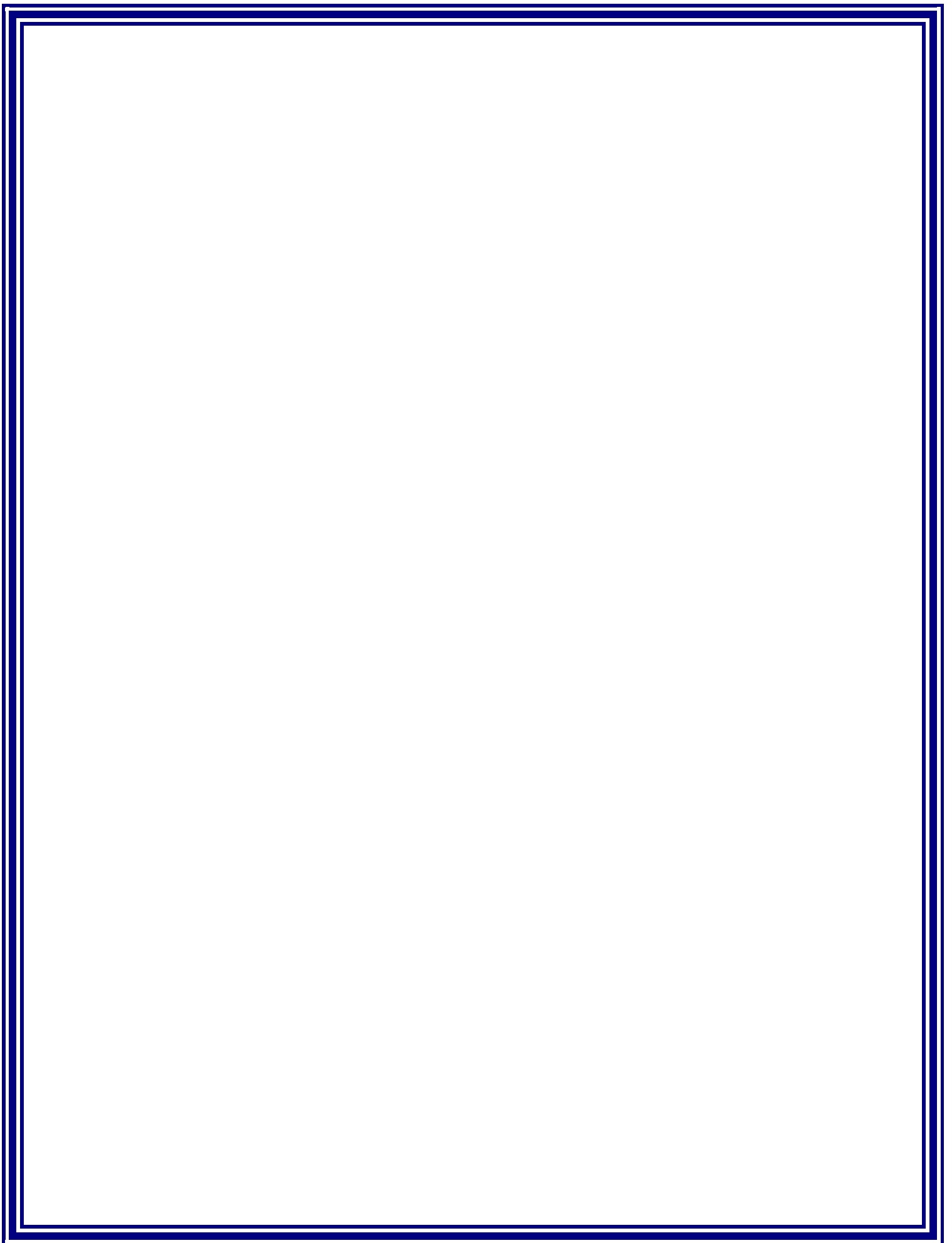

This park, which lies across the street from Pinckneyville Park, contains five lighted soccer fields, a concession building, restrooms, a 1.1-mile paved multi-purpose trail, two playgrounds, two ponds, a picnic pavilion, and several picnic spots. A walking trail connects to the Pinckneyville Community Center

Shorty Howell Park

Set around a small lake, Shorty Howell Park is one of the first parks purchased by the county. It features seven lighted youth baseball/softball fields, a concession building, a lighted track around a football field, a pavilion, two playgrounds and a 1.25 mile paved multi-purpose, along with a 1-mile mulch trail. A new 8,200-square-foot activity building opened in 2005, and houses a large community room with a catering kitchen, a classroom and offices for park police.



Master Plan for Successful Family Reunion

18-24 months before

- * Determine interest
- * Start mailing list
- * Form reunion committee (s) ; establish responsibilities and schedules
- * Keep records of everything
- * Develop budget and bookkeeping system
- * Scout locations and facilities
- * Contact convention and visitors or tourism bureaus

12 months before

- * Send first mailer, include names of missing persons, tentative schedule plans, suggestions (tours, souvenirs, memory books) theme and approximate cost
- * Set date (s)
- * Choose location
- * Select theme
- * Arrange or hire entertainment, caterer, photographer, videographer, printer

6-9 months before

- * Send second mailer, include registration form, cost and updated list of missing persons
- * Schedule events and activities-program, speakers, awards, ceremony, tours
- * Reserve block of rooms
- * Begin souvenir directory/list of attendees/memory book

5 months before

- * Confirm reservations, entertainment, photographer, caterer
- * Send mailing to newly-located people as they're found
- * Choose menu
- * Announce to local news media, elected officials

2-4 months before

- * Meet with staff, visit facility with reunion committee
- * Select decoration, sign, banners and order printed items
- * Reserve rental equipments
- * Submit personalized souvenir order (t-shirts, mugs etc)

Six weeks before

- * Complete directory/memory book, deliver to the printer
- * Write checklist for reunion task
- * Designate assignments for reunion volunteers

Two weeks before

- * Purchase last minute decorations and incidental supplies
- * Reconfirm meeting, sleeping and eating accommodations
- * Review final checklist
- *

The day before

- * Determine location staff contacts for your reunion
- * Solve last minute problems
- * Review final details with reunion committee

Reunion Day (s)

- * Set up registration tables, rental equipment, displays
- * Juggle details: volunteers, food, photographer, games, entertainment
- * Decorate
- * Salute volunteers
- * Enjoy

Afterwards

- * Reflect and evaluate – what worked, what did not
- * Complete bookkeeping, settle accounts
- * Write thank-you notes to volunteers, hotel staff, caterers
- * Start planning your next reunion Used by permission
